Lesson Title:

Making Rain

Grade Level:

All levels

Topic:

Connections to water (water cycle, rain forests, environmental, and

weather)

Time Required:

15 minutes

Objectives:

1. Students will become aware of variation and intensity of rain.

Students will be able to take a fun experience and relate it to 2.

3. Students will relate to "rain" from own experiences.

Materials:

A group of students

Procedure:

Divide group into 3 sections. 1.

Explain: Each group should do what you show them and 2. should not stop or change until you direct them otherwise.

Begin with the 1st group rubbing hands together, they continue, while you add the 2nd group and then the 3rd.

Go back to the 1st group and have them begin to snap fingers. 3.

4. Then add second and then third groups.

Repeat process by having students patting their laps. 5.

Repeat process by adding stomping feet. 6.

Continue process - but now reverse all the steps until everyone 7. is silent.

This is a fun activity that can be used to set the stage for any area concerning water and rain. All levels love it.
